INFORMATION SHEET FOR TRADE DISPLAYS

David Hack is primarily a classic vehicles and warbird show. We estimate over 3000 people attend the day. Sponsors may display some of their services goods free of charge as part of their sponsorship. If you wish to become a sponsor, please contact:

We may consider other displays if the David Hack Committee feels it is in keeping with the theme of the event. As the David Hack is a fundraiser for charity and our club does have some costs in organising the event, Trade displays will have fee for attendance and conditions.

Donation for attendance: \$80 or in kind which can be used as a raffle prize. A tax receipt will be provided after the event once an invoice is received.

Some of the things we consider: Are the products to be displayed/sold in keeping with the David Hack theme? Eg. to do with vehicles/ aircraft.

- Is the person prepared to make donation to David Hack? Trade Entry fee \$80 or in kind.
- Can the area required be easily accommodated at the David Hack?
- These three below will not be accepted:
 - Spare parts out of back of cars (not a swap meet)
 - Political advertising displays
 - Products to be sold in competition with Rotary Club of Toowoomba North – food, raffle, drinks etc.

Conditions:

1. Copy of Public Liability Insurance to be provided prior to 13th May
2. Arrival time Saturday 2pm-4pm or on Sunday set up by 8:00 am.
3. You will be told where to set up.
4. Need to be self-powered.
5. Ideally set up under own portable/ pop up marquees and tables.
6. Need to be self-sufficient.
7. Vehicles parked at the back fence unless the vehicle is a classic or is a van which is the display product store
8. Remove your rubbish and place in bins before departure from aerodrome.
9. No loud hailers
10. Courtesy and work with any neighbours
11. Cannot pack up until 2:30pm
12. Offsite no later 4:30pm Sunday
13. Rotary Club of Toowoomba North takes no responsibility for the loss of your stock through theft, accident or other event.

Cash or Card? You may have Eftpos or accept cash. There will be a mobile ATM near the big marquee for the general public to source cash.

Weather: We can organise a lot, unfortunately the weather is not one. Generally, rain or shine the David Hack goes ahead. There may be with some limitations. High wind speeds and or low cloud cover will mean aircraft cannot fly or land in Toowoomba. Rain will also limit some people bringing their pride and joy. Very wet ground will also limit the use of the aerodrome. However, some will come anyway. We will be there!! In the advent of very bad weather the David Hack may be postponed or cancelled. We will notify using all means available to us being radio stations, Facebook, our website and emails.

For out of towners: Toowoomba in May can be cool and we suggest you bring a jumper/ jacket just in case. Also on the other side, it can very sunny and hot so bring a hat and sunscreen.

Stay in touch with what is coming via our Facebook Page. Share it with your friends.

Location: Spitfire Street, Toowoomba City Aerodrome, Toowoomba, QLD 4350 Drive into Greenwattle Street, left into Mutze Street, then left again into Nomad Street and right into Spitfire Street. Follow the directions of our volunteers. Parking unless your vehicle is essential to the display, we will ask you to park on the aerodrome site near the back fence where volunteers park.

No Pets Allowed: Animals are not allowed on the aerodrome due to safety concerns. This is a Federal regulation. Exceptions are made for guidance dogs.

No Smoking is permitted at the David Hack site. It is an Aerodrome regulation.

Medical Emergency: We have basic first aid available, in an emergency please contact a volunteer (yellow hi-vis vest). An ambulance will be called via 000 if necessary.

Rubbish: We ask the public and trade displays to help us by disposing of their rubbish in one of the many wheelie bins which are dotted around the site. As you know, loose paper and plastic is a hazard to aircraft.

Facilities: Portable toilets are made available on site. There is one disabled toilet available in one of the Aerotec buildings in Spitfire Street. The information tent people can guide you there.

Closing Time is 2:30pm for the public and vehicle exhibitors. The aerodrome is an active aerodrome. Aircraft of course are exempt as they are already airside. We need to clean up and demobilise to return the Event area back to operational condition by 5pm on Sunday. This is a condition of use.
